COVID-19 Update June 24, 2020

Governor Cooper's Announcement

Today, Governor Cooper signed an Executive Order announcing the extension of Phase 2 reopening in NC. In addition, the Governor mandated all North Carolinians to wear a face covering in public places (indoor and outdoor), where social distancing is not possible. This order will go into effect Friday, June 26th at 5pm and will expire three weeks later on July 17th. Once we are able to move into Phase 3, the Governor is hopeful we can open gyms and bars with restrictions. For more information, here is the official [Executive Order](#).

The Visit High Point team will be upholding the Executive Order's requirements. Expect to see our staff wearing masks within public areas of the Visitors Center. We ask any visitors that wish to enter the Visitors Center to also wear a mask. If a visitor does not have a mask with them, one can be provided. Our goal is to maintain the safety of all staff and guests. As a reminder in Phase 2, we will continue to only hold in-person meetings of 10 people or less, where we can social distance and face masks are mandatory.
