Entering Into Phase 2

Dear Partners,

Today, Governor Cooper signed an Executive Order to start Phase 2 of reopening businesses that will go into effect Friday, May 22 at 5 p.m. In Phase 2, the "Stay At Home" order is lifted, but the Governor suggested to remain "Safer At Home." If you do plan to leave your house, follow the three W's:

Wear face coverings
Wait 6 feet away
Wash hands often

Here are the guidelines outlined in Phase 2:

Phase 2:

- Stay at home order is lifted
- Retail businesses can remain open at 50% capacity with frequent cleaning and social distancing
- Gatherings limited to 10 people indoors and 25 people outdoors
- Restaurants can allow dine-in service at 50% capacity with strict cleaning requirements
- Certain businesses (gyms, bars, indoor venues, playgrounds, etc.) will remain closed
- Personal care, grooming, and tattoo businesses can reopen at 50% capacity with restrictions
- Indoor and Outdoor public swimming pools can open with 50% capacity
- Overnight and Day camps are allowed with strict cleaning procedures and restrictions

The Executive Order to enter into Phase 2 of reopening businesses is set to expire on June 26 at 5 p.m. but could be extended if there is a spike in the state's numbers and trends. To read the full order in detail, [click here](#).
