HIGH POINT, N.C., March 4, 2020 As a part of the Partners of Excellence Program and to ensure that safety comes first, the High Point Convention & Visitors Bureau is offering a ServSafe® Manager class and exam on Thursday, March 19, 2020 from 8:30 a.m. – 5 p.m. The ServSafe® Manager course is designed to teach individuals about safe food handling and preparation. In addition, this course meets the compliance of the NC Dept. of Health guidelines during routine health inspections. The 1-Day class is taught in an upbeat and informative manner and includes a complimentary Food Handler guide for all participants. The class will be held at the High Point Convention and Visitors Bureau, 1634 North Main Street, Suite 102, High Point, NC 27262.

Raise-the-Grade®, will lead the instruction for the 1-day class and the exam administration. Upon successful completion, examinees will receive their ServSafe® Manager certificate, which is valid for 5 years, approximately 8-10 business days after the class.

The cost of the class for HPCVB attendees is \$104.30 (a 30% discount), which includes everything needed for the class day, the exam, and light refreshments throughout the day. Early registration is suggested as space is limited.
