

High Point CVB Update 3/25/2020

Dear Partners,

Today, March 25, the City of High Point and the City of Greensboro and Guilford County Officials have jointly issued a "stay at home" order for Guilford County effective Friday, March 27 at 5pm through Thursday, April 16. This order will require all non-essential businesses to close. Essential businesses include the following:

- grocery stores
- pharmacies
- gas stations
- banks
- media organizations
- funeral homes
- child care centers

Community members are allowed to go outside for walking, hiking, running, biking, golfing and playing tennis. Golfing and tennis can only be played if there is social distancing. However, public playgrounds will be closed starting tomorrow, March 26. Signs will be placed outside of the structures to indicate they are not to be used. All City of High Point parks will remain open and are observing regular hours of operation.
